

Yurts.ie Warranty is subject to the following Terms and Conditions:

The warranty is valid for the original retail purchaser from the date of initial commissioning and is non-transferable.

The warranty covers defects in materials or workmanship that arise during the normal and intended use of the yurt. It does not cover any damages resulting from alterations made to the yurt misuse, neglect, abuse, vandalism, accidents, man-made damage or natural disasters, such as but not limited to fires, floods or storms\*, damage caused by external causes or acts of God.

To make a warranty claim, the original purchaser must contact us and provide proof of purchase and shall give written notice of any alleged failure of the structure, seams or fabric within this limited warranty period, no later than 15 days after the Purchaser learns of such failure.

Our obligation under this warranty is limited to repairing or replacing, at our discretion, any defective part or component of the yurt. If we determine that the defect is not covered by the warranty, we will provide an estimate for any necessary repairs or replacements. Any repairs or replacements made under the warranty will be made with comparable materials and may not be an exact match to the original yurt.

The warranty does not cover any costs associated with repositioning, removing or reinstalling the yurt or any of its components.

Limitation of Actions. No action for breach of warranty shall be commenced by the Purchaser more than one year after the accrual of the alleged cause of action.

Modifications of this warranty, or waiver of its terms, shall only be binding on either party when approved and in writing by both parties.

Limitation of Liability. It is understood and agreed that Yurts.ie's liability, whether in contract, in tort, under any warranty, in negligence or otherwise, shall be limited to the undertaking set out above of this Limited Warranty, and under no circumstances shall Yurts.ie be liable for special, indirect or consequential damages. The price stated for the items purchased is a consideration in limiting Yurts.ie's liability.

\*Storm and 'Storm Damage':

A storm is generally categorised as such and sometimes 'named'. They can come with red or yellow warnings from weather bureaus such as Met Eireann, and can have violent winds and gusts. It may or may not be accompanied by torrential rain, hail and snow. The storm conditions occur on the same date or dates that 'storm damage' is said to have occurred and the damage is consistent with similar damage in the same general vicinity.
